 - O 38 players maximum, first come first serve, no entry fee.
 - Must have played in 4 tournaments to be eligible.
- Battle of the Pines Ryder Cup style tournament October 18-19.

- 48 players, must have played in three MGA events.
- Saturday Morning and Sunday Afternoon starts.
- Saturday will be Alternate Shot, Best Ball and Scramble
- Sunday will be Match Play.
- o \$45.00 entry fee includes Polo and Cap with logo.

Communications Report:

- Communication Director Art Keaton will fill this position to complete the term vacated by Hal Holloway.
- Indicated that Debit card has been made available and active.

UPDATE FROM GOLF PRO/JEFF WILSON

- Greens are great and will be prime for Club Championship.
- There is a consensus by the Board that outside play will be acceptable in the future.
- There will be discussions of continuing Shotgun starts during the deep winter months due to frost delays. This may evolve into one shotgun start per day so schedule can be maintained.
- Shirts for Battle of the pines will be green and blue with logo on arm and chest.

New Business/ Open Discussion:

- Once new parameters for play are established, there will be no 5-somes during morning play.
- Outside play will be limited to 4-somes only.
- There will be 2 open positions for the MGA Board for next year. These will be 2-year terms.
 - There will be a sign-up sheet for those interested in being a member of the MGA board prior to the election.
- Some of the concepts for general play and behavioral rules for consideration are as follows:

- The MGA will conduct its tournaments in accordance with USGA rules, and any local rules and handicaps must be established prior to any tournament being played.
 - A handicap committee should be established which should be comprised of 2 MGA members and 1 pro shop employee.
- MGA members must have at least 2 scores posted in GHIN each calendar month to be eligible to play in any tournament.
 - There will be exceptions in case of health or other emergency issues on a case by case consideration.
- MGA members below the age of 60 will play from the White Tee Markers. Members 60 and older can play from the Gold Tees. If members age and handicap equals 95 or above may play from the Green Tees.
- Anyone who wishes to play in the Club Championship must have at least 10 scores posted in GHIN in that calendar year. The handicap limit to play in the Club Championship from the Blue Tees will be established by the Tournament Committee. Currently it is a GHIN index of 11.5.
- To be eligible to play in the Pine Cone Cup, members and guest must have an established handicap. No professional golfers will be allowed to participate in the Pine Cone Cup.
- The Tournament Committee will establish any other local rules with the assistance of the Director of Golf.
